Plants

After our gray, dismal winter, we are soon going to be ready to get out and tidy up our gardens for Spring! Don't throw those over-grown or extra plants away — re-pot them and set them aside for our May 12th sale!

Don't just think perennials . . . we also sell trees, shrubs, annuals, bulbs, vegetable plants. Plants should be labeled (include Latin names, if known), marked if they are for sun or shade and contain enough soil to support them.

Old pots: We also need old pots for others to use for their plants. If anyone has pots to donate, you can take them to the Star Garden **after April 7** and put them "on the rocks" near the water spigot. If you need pots for your plantings, please feel free to check at the garden and take what you need!

Yard Sale Items

We accept most items for the yard sale, *except* clothing, large appliances and electronics. Items should be clean and in good condition. While you're doing your Spring cleaning, set aside your unwanted household items, toys, games, books, knick knacks, etc and donate them to the club. Your unwanted gardening items are especially popular at the sale.
